Short CV: Aydin Nassehi, University of Bristol's Head of School of Electrical, Electronic and Mechanical Engineering, is an academic active in production systems research. With a Ph.D. from Bath and an M.Sc. from Oxford, he's renowned for his leadership in academia and research, contributing over 150 publications and securing significant grants. A CIRP Fellow, Nassehi's work significantly impacts global manufacturing systems design and interoperability.

Main research and industrial topics: Digital-enabled manufacturing, interoperability, autoarchic production systems, assessment of economic viability of production and remanufacturing scenarios. Works closely with industry on assembly and disassembly digital twins as well as purposeful additive manufacturing and generative design.
