Welcome to Italy!



Your Rome city break begins with the outward flight. At Fiumicino Airport you will be brought to the hotel in a modern and fully air-conditioned bus. On the way we will have a guided tour of the Sanct Callistus catacomb and a short walk along the Roman Via Appia. Then we will visit the Basilica of St. Paul outside the walls.



DAY 2

Look forward to the highlight of the trip, the Vatican with its museums and the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica! Experience the magic of the smallest city in the world. After a short metro ride you will reach St. Peter's Square. The atmosphere of the huge square with the Bernini colonnades is unique. St. Peter's Basilica also shines with its perfect forms and the dome designed by Michelangelo. It is still the largest church in the world. After the interior tour of the Vatican Museums, admire the Raphael rooms and the Sistine Chapel, followed by a visit to St. Peter's Basilica. Stop for a photo at the famous Castel Sant'Angelo. It got its name after Pope Gregory an angel appeared on the top of the bastion during a plague epidemic, announcing the end of the epidemic. Since then it has served as the Pope's protective castle, which is also connected to the Vatican by



a hidden passage. You can also enjoy the great view over the Tiber and the city. Let's be the most beautiful square in Rome, Piazza Navona, is the next photo stop on our tour. The oval square used to be a stadium of the Emperor Domitian. Today he is Rome's "good room". The impressive fountains of the Four Rivers (Fontana die Fiumi) and the Mohrenbrunnen (Fontana del



Moro) are popular photo opportunities. Another highlight of this tour is the great Pantheon, which you can also admire from the inside.

DAY3

The Coliseum is a short ride on the Metro. As soon as you get off the subway, the beauty of the Flavios amphitheater opens up to you. With your VIP ticket you can enter the interior of the Colosseum without waiting. After visiting this ancient masterpiece, we continue to the Arc de Triomphe and Palatine Hill. This first home of the Romans is a must for anyone interested in history. The people who laid the foundation stone for the Roman Empire finally lived on this hill. The route takes you across the Roman Forum to the Trajan's Column and Piazza Venezia with the Capitol. If you look at the romantic, somewhat overgrown ruins of the Roman Forum, you can see immediately that this was once the meeting point of ancient Rome. The center of power of the entire Roman Empire was also located here. Lunch break. After your break, explore the Centro Storico, led by your tour guide. The tour of the old town begins in Piazza Venezia, in front of the Monument Vittorio Emanuele II. You then walk north along the promenade Via del Corso to fall under the magic of the Trevi Fountain (Fontana di Trevi). Incidentally, it is a good practice to throw a coin into the well. This ensures that you will visit Rome again. Today's program ends at the Spanish Steps. Now you can either take the underground back to the hotel accompanied by the tour guide or you can dive into the alleys of Rome again on your own. The evening is then at your leisure.
