



**CAPPUCCINO TOUR OPERATOR**  
**WINE AND FOOD ITALY TOUR**

**1 DAY:** Arrival at Palermo Airport, transfer to the hotel in Marsala area and room allocation. Welcome cocktail and then a Sicilian specialty menu. Overnight

**2. DAY:** After Breakfast , visit to the "Baglio Anselmi" Archaeological Museum in Marsala, where the remains of a Punic ship from the 3rd century BC are located. Visit to a cellar and small tasting with different wines. Departure for Trapani along the salt pans with the characteristic windmills, continuing up to Erice, a small medieval town, a small walk in the village through the picturesque alleys with flower-filled courtyards.



Visit to a patisserie where almond specialties, the so-called "Ericini" are produced and tasting of the typical almond biscuits and the famous Marsala, dessert wine. Return to hotel, dinner and



overnight.

**3. DAY:** After Breakfast, drive to Selinunte, the westernmost Greek colony in Sicily, and visit the archaeological zone (east hill and acropolis). Specialty food in a seafood restaurant. Possibility depending on the season to visit a winery or an oil mill at Menfi. Continue to Segesta, once the most powerful Elymer city in Sicily. Visit to the Doric temple from the 5th century BC and the theater. Return to the hotel, dinner



and overnight.

**4. DAY:** In the morning drive to Palermo and walk through the picturesque Arabian market "Vucciria" (only on weekdays) with its abundance of products typical of the country and its unmistakable Mediterranean atmosphere (market cries etc.) Cappella Palatina in the Norman Palace, a jewel of Byzantine mosaic art, the Church of San Giovanni degli Eremiti and / or "La Martorana", whose red domes refer to typical Arabic architecture. Midday snack in the Palermitan style with



"Arancine" (filled rice balls), "Pannele" (chickpea flatbread), croquettes and possibly (for the very brave) with a spleen roll. Visit the cathedral of Monreale with its beautiful gold mosaics and the adjacent cloister of the



Benedictine monastery. Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight

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**5. DAY:** Drive to the fishing town of Sciacca, which has been famous for its healing thermal baths since ancient times. Short photo stop and opportunity for a walk through the town. Lunch in a specialty restaurant in or near Agrigento. Continue to Agrigento to visit the "Valley of the Temples" (Temple of Juno, Concordia, Hercules, Zeus, Castor and Pollux). Return to the hotel. Dinner and overnight.



**6. DAY:** Drive to Salemi. The place is on a small mountain, from where you have a wonderful view of the surroundings. Walk to the Norman castle and visit the cathedral. Continuation in the Belice valley to Gibellina. The site was rebuilt elsewhere after being destroyed by the powerful 1968 earthquake and covered with works by contemporary artists. Panoramic trip through the picturesque villages of Santa Ninfa and Partanna to Montevago to the thermal sulfur baths. On the way, stop in a cheese dairy with a small snack. On the way back short stop in Santa Margherita di Belice and Poggioreale. Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.



**7. DAY:** After breakfast transfer to Palermo airport and flight home.

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
