

Cookie Policy

1. Introduction

1.1 Our website uses cookies.

1.2 Insofar as those cookies are not strictly necessary for the provision of our website and services, we will ask you to consent to our use of cookies when you first visit our website.

2. About cookies

2.1 A cookie is a small file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent by a web server to a web browser and is stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server.

2.2 Cookies do not typically contain any information that personally identifies a user, but personal information that we store about you may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.

3. Types of Cookies

3.1 Session and Persistent Cookies

A persistent cookie will be stored by a web browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date, unless deleted by the user before the expiry date. A session cookie, on the other hand, will expire at the end of the user session, when the web browser is closed.

3.2 First-party and third-party Cookies

First-party Cookies belong to the website that created them. Third-party Cookies are created by domains other than the one you are visiting directly and their data are stored at third destinations.

3.3 Technical and Profiling Cookies

Technical cookies are those used exclusively with a view to carrying out the transmission of a communication on an electronic communications network, or insofar as this is strictly necessary to the provider of an information society service that has been explicitly requested by the contracting party or user to provide the said service. (see Section 122(1) of the Italian personal data protection Code). They are not used for further purposes and are usually installed directly by the data controller or the website manager. For instance, there are Functional Cookies, which allow users to navigate as a function of certain pre-determined criteria such as language to improve the quality of service. Analytics Cookies are similar to Technical Cookies because they are used directly by the website manager to collect information in aggregated form about the number of users and how they visit the website. Profiling cookies are aimed at creating user profiles and they are used to send ads messages in line with the preferences shown by the user during navigation. In the light of the highly invasive nature of these cookies vis-à-vis users' private sphere, Italian and European legislation requires users to be informed appropriately on their use so as to give their valid consent.

4. Cookies that we use

4.1 We use cookies for the following purposes:

(a) Cookie consent: it is a first-party cookie with the purpose to hide the Cookie Policy in case of user acceptance;

(b) language choice on the website: it is a first-party cookie that inserts automations related to selections requested by some web pages.

5. Cookies used by our service provider

5.1 Our service provider uses cookies and those cookies may be stored on your computer when you visit our website.
